- **Guidelines for abstract submissions:**

1. **Deadline for submission of abstract: May 31, 2014**

Notification of abstract acceptance: June 16, 2014

2. **Only e-mail submissions will be accepted.**

3. **Abstract formats (The content should be written in APA style)**

- The abstract should be sent as **MS Word document** with A4 paper size, Times New Roman, 12 point font, and single spacing.

- **Each e-mail submission should INCLUDE the Author and Abstract information.** (Please refer to the attachments at the end of this file.)

1. **Author Form**: author name(s), affiliation, email address, etc.

2. **Abstract Form**: maximum 300 words; including title, background, methods, results, and conclusions.

4. The length of abstract should be within 300 words. The length of abstract and bibliography should be **within 2 pages**.

5. **All abstracts CANNOT be revised once they are submitted.**

- We will e-mail the **notification of receipt** to the first author within 5 working days.

<Please make sure that you have received the notification from us after submitting. In case that you did not receive our notification in time, please contact us and resubmitted your abstract.>

- We will notify you of the results of our review process via e-mail by **June 16, 2014**. Those who are accepted as presenters are required to **reply within two weeks** upon notification if they are willing to present their papers at the conference.

- **About the presentations:**

1. **Oral :**

The time of an oral presentation will be 20 minutes followed by a 10-minute discussion (with a total of 30 minutes). Invited speakers and keynote speakers will have additional time for their presentations.

2. Poster :

Each presentation will be provided with a 90 cm (width) x 120 cm (length) vertical poster stand.

Conference Proceedings

Conference proceedings will be published along with the conference. If you are interested in publishing your full paper in the proceedings, please submit your manuscript following the instructions in the guidelines below.

Guidelines for full paper submissions:

1. Deadline for submission of full papers: August 31, 2014

Notification of full paper acceptance: September 30, 2014

2. Manuscript formats

The full paper should be sent as MS Word document with Times New Roman, 12 point font, and single spacing with the following information:

Author information: author name(s), affiliation, email address.

Full paper information (maximum 6000 words): Abstract (no longer than 300 words), background, methods, results, and conclusions.

Notification of abstract acceptance: **June 16, 2014**

Deadline for submission of full papers: **August 31, 2014**

Notification of full paper acceptance: **September 30, 2014**
